Undersheriff Carver:

- Legislative Session passed amendments to prostitution & solicitation statute; one of the sections is under exploiting prostitution; if a person is guilty of exploiting prostitution, owns, controls,

manages, supervises or otherwise keeps a loaner in association with another, a place or business where prostitution occurs or is arranged, encourages, supported or promoted.

- It is intended for you to go to your city licensing offices and code enforcement and ensure that the business license matches the language for enforcement. If you can show that prostitution is being arranged, encouraged or promoted you then can pull their business license.
- The code is 76-10-1305 it will go into effect May 5<sup>th</sup>.
- You can look up all the amendments to those various statutes.
- CAB update; With the changes in the organizations now the precincts are responsible for the ongoing structure, organization and use & growth of CAB – any reports back on your efforts so we are aware would be appreciated that way we can track it and manage it.

- Wanted to thank Captain Ownby and his team for his assistance with a case over the weekend, they did a great job.

Captain Ownby:

- I am still waiting for some cities to send me there information on their city ordinances for licensing and cards so we have it up in the Investigations Division. If your city has adopted the County Ordinance then send me an email with that information.

Captain Herlin:

- Thank you to commanders for giving me people to help with the shoot.
- We have classes scheduled in June, looking forward to Taser Instructor, Firearms Instructor, Rifle Instructor and OC Instructor. If you have people who are interested in being instructors please send me the info.
- ATF is clarifying what applications and notifications of firearms sales and possession of Class C firearms by citizens in your communities. We will outline what is required to be done so all federal regulations are met. I hope to suggest a data base the information can be entered into easily that wil provide a history at the address so officers can know of these things should they be going to the houses.
- EVO starts May 15<sup>th</sup>, we should launch the online course hopefully today; anyone can take the online course right now and get 2 hours training, this will be mandatory for them to take to get credit for the 4 hour EVO training on the track.
- Pursuit training; we will put the Sergeants, Lieutenant’s & Commanders in the IC position.

Captain Fassett:

- Body Cams; currently Holladay, Midvale & Civil are in use.
- Upcoming will be a training for Lieutenants on how to review.

- Equipment; the collar block camera is what will be issued out.
- We have a package that allows unlimited storage.
- Accidental recordings (bathroom use, home use, etc.) need to be reported and coded so it can be properly reviewed.
- More Body cams will be rolled out in the next few weeks.
