- I will be creating a "split committee"- The objective of the committee will be to look at all the pros and cons of the split.
- Watch Command; anyone have any issues or feedback for watch commanders? We are working on cleaning up the watch command logs and making it easier to read with more detail.

- Upcoming selection for the Riverton Chief position, will announce who come September.

UPD COMMAND STAFF MEETING

- Special Order will be going out today with an update on our DV template – it will have an assessment on the threat level. Please make sure everyone updates their tables and uses the new template.
- Reminder: Sergeant Andreason has been sending out individual rotations to commanders for members in specialty positions who have reached their five year mark – Policy states Commanders can grant an individual a one year extension, any extensions after that need to be approved by the Management team.
- We went to the Merit Commission last week and we will not be doing another Sergeant's exam this year, we have asked to continue with the list we currently have. September 2019 will be the next sergeant's exam.
- We currently have 7 officers in FTO they will be available come October. We have 5 in the academy and 14 laterals currently in the background process.
- We are currently recruiting for new hires, recruitment will close mid-September.
- Constant Manning; we are having a difficult time getting our members to fill the Constant Manning shifts, we need to come up with a solution to make sure we are filling these shifts.

Chief Debry

- Millcreek; starting to change their format with the city council meetings, they are also looking to move into a permanent city office and possibly moving our precinct into that building as well; more information to come.
- We selected Officer A. Ricci as the new SRO at Skyline High School.

Chief Mazuran

- Operation Rio Grande; Continues with the Governor's Office and Legislature leading the effort to clean up the Rio Grande Area. Law Enforcement, jail and treatment are the main areas being explored; our officers are working two shifts per week this week and one shift per week per person starting next week.

Chief Hutson

- Operation Rio Grande; is someone in Administration going to be talking about the operation at the UPD board meeting – we need to get a uniformed message out.

- Smartsheets; we are starting to roll a lot more things into Smartsheets, it makes it a lot easier to share/gather information. Transfer requests and performance evals are now on Smartsheets.
- We will be changing out our work comp carrier within the next few days and we will send that information out, this will be an overnight change and we will announce it when it takes effect.

- Still working on the timeclock plus system
- When looking at travel requests from your people don't just assume it will be cheaper driving based on the distance.
