Sherriff Rivera

- Youth Services: will be moving to West Jordan.
- I need 3 patrol officers who are well trained on MDT and can assist dispatch with testing.
- New Magna Substation is gorgeous – very impressed, the Ribbon cutting/grand opening will be September 14th at 1400.
- New Herriman Precinct grand opening is September 22nd.
