CHIEF HUDSON

- Riverton City has selected Lieutenant Jake Petersen as their new Chief. Riverton City will officially confirm him on October 3rd at their city council meeting. Congratulations to Jake.
- New Drug court started up out of the Rio Grande project, the funding was approved by the Salt Lake County Council and will also be forwarded to the State in their interim meeting today. We have facilitated for Kevin Mathews to go into that court immediately.
- UPD will not be splitting away from the Office of the Sheriff, no is there legislative intent to do so.
- Reminder that all pursuits need to be brought to Management Team for discussion.
- Runaways: it has been decided that runaways from JRC will be handled through the agency where the individual resides if there is not a PSO at JRC. If a runaway from JRC is handled by UPD, it can be done by phone. A special order will be sent out with more details.
- FBI National Academy: Applications open to lieutenant and above, we do not have a specific date for an opening as of yet. Applications must be filled out and on the list for a year to be eligible.
- Granite PD: After 7pm if there is an incident at a Granite District School and the suspect is not on scene and it is an information only report, it should be handled by the jurisdictional agency. GPD dispatch will be notified so they can follow up.
- Major incidents: keep in mind school start times and school out times. Also, remember that on Friday's it's early out day. If there is ever a major event near a school remember to notify Granite PD and/or get those schools locked down/protected.
- We have 7 coming out of FTO and they will be assigned on Oct 8th.
- Laterals: 10 will be interviewed on Friday, those who move forward will be hired & ready to be assigned in January.
- We have 5 in post and they graduate Sept 21st. If they pass FTO, they will be assigned in February 2018.
